

Competition Teams

Sign up for the Competition Teams will occur Sunday September 16, 23, and 30.

Competition team training will start on Sunday 14 October (TBC). The training occurs for **1-2 hours before regular training** on Sunday (depending on team and how practices are going).

The various teams are:

- Drill: The cadets will learn to improve their standing and marching drill.
- Seamanship: Cadets will learn in-depth knot knowledge, shipboard terminology, and ranks
- Semaphore: Cadets will learn how to signal messages with hand-held flags
- First aid: Cadets will learn how to do first aid and manage a scene
- Fife and Drum: While not a team that competes, cadets will learn about drumming and playing fife

Cadets not required to sign up for any team and can simply attend regular training. However, if they do sign up it is expected they be **able to attend team practices until the end of February and perhaps until April** (when Provincial Competitions are held).

All teams have a limited number of spots. Depending on how many cadets sign up for each team, there may be try-outs later in the team training. It should be noted that signing up for a Competition Team is **not a guarantee** your child will be on a Competition Team.

Fife and Drum

Sign up for the Fife and drum will occur Sunday September 16, 23, and 30.

Fife and drum training will commence Sunday 14 October (TBC).

While not a team that competes cadet members of the Fife and Drum will learn about drumming and playing fife.
